ALBERT PERRY ROCKWOOD - MILITARY MAN

Albert Perry Rockwood was born June 9, 1805 in Holliston, Middlesex county, Massachusetts, the son of Luther and Ruth Perry Rockwood. His mother died two months after he was born, so Albert lived with his half-brothers and sisters in the old home until 1827, when he married Nancy Haven. Their first child, Elizabeth, died at the age of eleven years. Ellen Ackland Rockwood, the second daughter, was born March 23, 1829. She later became the wife of Brigham Young. Four other children were born to this couple but all died in infancy.

During the year 1837, Brigham Young and Willard Richards came to Holliston, converting many of the people to the Mormon faith, among whom were Albert and Nancy. Soon after they moved to Kirtland, Ohio where the Saints were then located. Because of his interest and knowledge of military tactics he was appointed to command the Prophet's body guard and later ranked as general in the Nauvoo Legion. Having been called to fill a vacancy in the First Council of Seventies, Elder Rockwood was ordained and set apart as one of the First

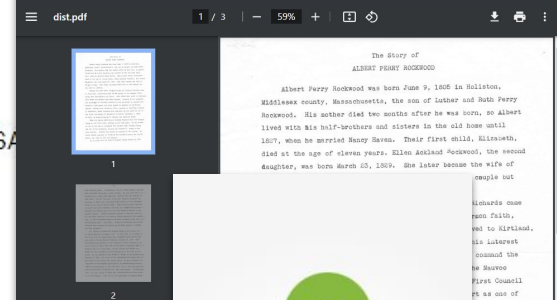

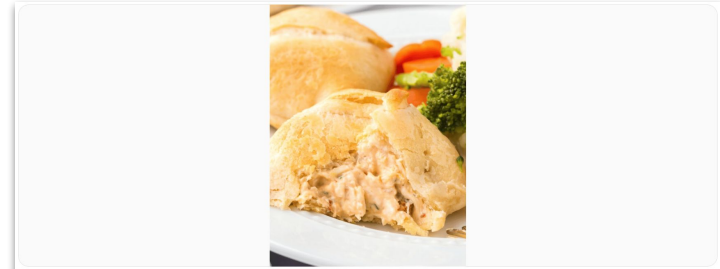

Chicken Pillows

When Elena and I first started dating, she invited me over to her apartment and made me one of her family's favorite recipes, Chicken Pillows. After my first bite, I knew I was in love, both with Chicken Pillows and Elena. We chuckle now because it wasn't until after our wedding that I learned her cooking prowess was limited to chicken pillows and caramel brownies. We've come a long way since those early days, and chicken pillows are still a staple at our house when we want to dig into some delicious comfort food.

Ingredients

Chicken Pillow Filling

- ¼ tsp pepper
- 4 chicken breasts - shredded
- ½ cup butter
- 8 oz cream cheese (softened)
- 4 oz can green chilies
- 2 cans Pillsbury crescent rolls

Sauce

- 1 can cream of chicken soup
- 1 can cream of mushroom soup
- 1 cup of milk

Directions

1. Preheat oven to 350° F. Line a cookie sheet with parchment paper or tin foil. This just helps prevent any sticking and makes clean-up much easier.
2. Mix butter, cream cheese, pepper, chilies until smooth
3. Mix in shredded chicken
4. Roll out crescent rolls. Some people do triangles, but we leave two triangles together to make square pillows.
5. Roll up while using your fingers to pinch the edges together and the seams. Place on the prepared cookie sheet.
6. Spread butter on top of the completed chicken pillows




BIRD-HAMILTON



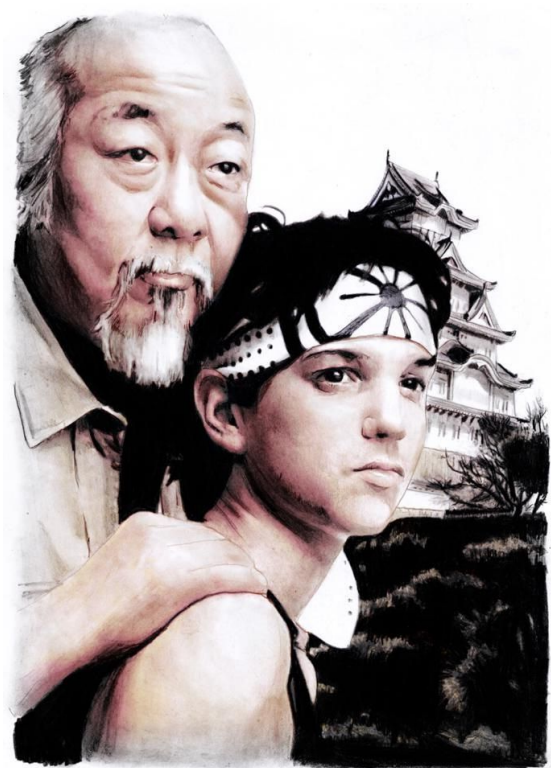

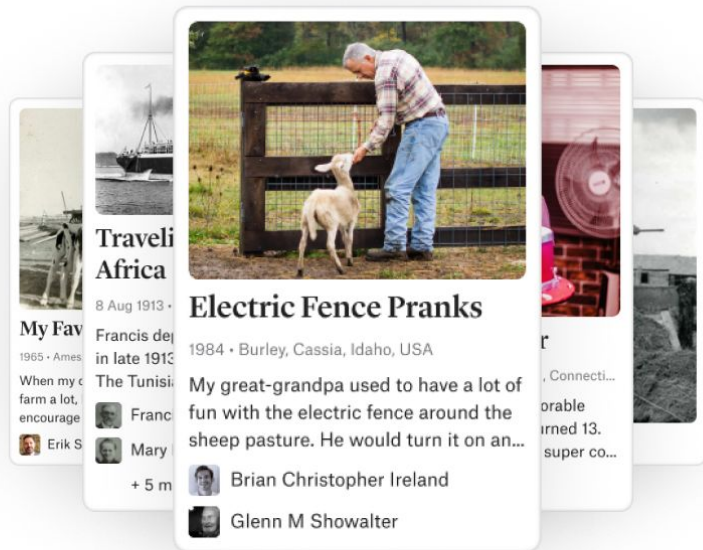
